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- ISA+ is an advanced implementation science academy for investigators ready to move beyond identifying barriers and facilitators toward designing, testing, and sustaining implementation strategies.

- ISA+ emphasizes the practical decisions investigators face when developing implementation strategies, conducting hybrid trials, incorporating equity and economic evaluation, publishing findings, and adapting when studies do not go as planned.
